Subject: Indefinite Suspension of the Hunting Panel

Since our last meeting in June 2019, a number of members have resigned from the panel citing that the panel was a waste of their time and that no panel suggestions were considered or implemented. I do regret that those members felt that the panel was a waste of their time, as that was never my intent.

Based on the feedback received through various platforms I have been made to feel that I am not the appropriate person to continue to chair the hunting panel. This memorandum is to indefinitely suspend the hunting panel. The hunting panel was a trial run that I chose to take on to give the hunters a voice. Panel members' suggestions and input were taken and considered but ultimately, as stated at the first meeting, only the appointed Natural Resources Manager is authorized to make decisions about management of natural resources at JBSA. Some of the suggestions were implemented, some were not, and some were implemented in ways that were not as the panel expected.

I do believe the hunting program is an important privilege to keep alive at Camp Bullis. I would like you to know I have been and will continue to be a voice for keeping the program, increasing hunting opportunities overall, and trying to maximize available areas for hunters when natural resources and mission allows.

As mentioned above, the panel is indefinitely suspended. When/if the panel is re-instated with an appropriate chairperson a formal announcement will be made.
